



CONSENT FORM

Each person taking part in sled dog activities provided by Mynydd Sleddog Adventures is required to read, complete and sign this document. Or, in the case of a young person under the age of 18, this document will need to be signed by a parent, guardian or responsible adult.

By signing this document, you are confirming that you have read and understood all the information and risks associated with sled dog activities.

All participants must listen to all safety briefings and instructions before taking part in any activities. You must NOT partake in any activity if you have not understood the briefings and/or instructions. If you require more assistance or instruction, please do not hesitate to ask the Adventure Leader.

All participants and observers must listen to, and obey, all instructions given by Mynydd Sleddog Adventures' Leader at all times, in particular instructions relating to our dogs.

All participants must understand that sled dog sports can be a dangerous activity. Whilst all efforts are made to safeguard our customers from such dangers, accidents and injuries can happen. A full risk assessment has been prepared by Mynydd Sleddog Adventures Ltd. to address possible eventualities and minimise hazards where possible.

Sled dog welfare is of paramount importance to us. Mynydd Sleddog Adventures reserves the right to terminate any activity with immediate effect if there are concerns for a dog's welfare and/or if the Adventure Leader considers that participants are not following the rules and instructions:

- All protective equipment including head protection, gloves and protective eye wear must be worn for the duration of the activity.
- All equipment must remain on site and returned after use.
- All equipment remains the property of Mynydd Sleddog Adventures and, in the event of any damage being caused to the equipment through fault of the user, the participant is liable to pay for the repair/replacement.
- Mynydd Sleddog Adventures is not liable for damage to, or loss of, property belonging to participants, however incurred.
- All existing injuries, health issues or learning difficulties that may affect you taking part in this activity must be reported to the Adventure Leader before taking part and noted in the appropriate section of this disclaimer (e.g. heart problems, asthma, diabetes, epilepsy, learning difficulties, etc.), this will enable us to adapt your adventure accordingly.
- Threatening or abusive behaviour towards any sled dog, Mynydd Sleddog Adventure staff or other visitor on site is not tolerated. Any behaviour of this sort will result in your adventure being terminated and you being asked to leave the site.
- Strictly no alcohol or non-prescription drugs are to be consumed before or during any activity. If the Adventure Leader suspects that you are under the influence of alcohol or illegal substances, you will not be permitted to take part in any adventures.





In agreeing to take part in this activity and signing this consent form, you are acknowledging these dangers and agree to take part at your own discretion.

PRIVACY POLICY

Mynydd Sleddog Adventures Ltd. is committed to complying with the General Data Protection Regulation and the Data Protection Act 2018. Looking after the personal information you share with us is very important, and we want you to be confident that your personal data is kept safely and securely and to understand how we use it.

Information we collect from you

When participating in activities offered by Mynydd Sleddog Adventures, you will be required to complete and sign a disclaimer document. We will ask you to provide some personal information such as; full name, address, date of birth, contact number and email address as well as any medical conditions or learning difficulties.

How do we use your information?

Data Protection says that we are allowed to use your personal data only where we have a proper reason to do so and these are: Legitimate Interests; ensuring that we provide a service that is suitable to everyone's individual needs. We will not share your information with any other third parties.

How long we keep your information

When we collect your personal information, the length of time we retain it is determined by a number of factors including the purpose for which we use that information and our obligations under other laws.

We retain your personal information for 7 years after the date it is no longer needed by us for any of the purposes listed under "How we use your information" above. The only exceptions to this are where:

- The law requires us to hold your personal information for a longer period, or delete it sooner;
- You exercise your right to have the information erased (where it applies) and we do not need to hold it in connection with any of the reasons permitted or required under the law;
- We bring or defend a legal claim or other proceedings during the period we retain your personal information, in which case we will retain your personal information until those proceedings have concluded and no further appeals are possible.





What are your rights?

You have the right to know what personal information we maintain about you. We will provide you with a copy of your personal information in a structured, commonly-used and machine-readable format on request. If your personal information is incorrect or incomplete, you have the right to ask us to update it.

You have the right to object to our processing of your personal information. You can also ask us to delete or restrict how we use your personal information, but this right is determined by applicable law and may impact your access to our services.
